
## **Function**

The Zener Barrier prevents the transfer of unacceptably high energy from the safe area into the hazardous area.

If this voltage is exceeded, due to a fault in the safe area, the diodes start to conduct, causing the fuse to blow. The Zener Barrier has a negative polarity, i. e. the cathodes of the zener diodes are grounded.

Additionally this Zener Barrier is equipped with a replaceable fuse.




